Victim in home invasion named

Man dies after stabbing

Police have identified a man who died from stab wounds after an apparent home invasion on Bogert Avenue Thursday. Police have also released a security camera image on Monday of two suspects wanted in the investigation.

Police were called to the Yonge Street and Sheppard Avenue area around 9:20 p.m. and found a 28-year-old man with stab wounds. He was taken to hospital and later died.

Police said two men entered the apartment, which had four occupants at the time. One of the men, armed with a gun, demanded cash and drugs from one of the occupants.

A developer partner has been selected for Phase 1 of the Lawrence Heights revitalization, Toronto Community Housing's

board of directors announced Monday.

The developer partner and construction manager duties

will be a joint venture between Context and Metroproa Inc.

Phase 1 will cover 10 hectares (25 acres) and will include the

construction of 233 replacement rent-g geared-to-income units and 828 market condominiums and townhouses, as

well as new retail space and parkland at Lawrence Avenue and Allen Road.
